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NONPROFITS JOIN FORCES TO FORM NATIONAL NONPROFIT JOBS WEBSITE

Collaborative Effort Will Benefit Nonprofit Employers and Job Seekers

The Center for Nonprofit Management in Los Angeles has teamed up with Executive Service Corps of New England in Boston and the Nonprofit Center at La Salle University in Philadelphia to launch a national job listing website at www.nonprofitjobscoop.org.

Launched on November 18, 2005, the Nonprofit Jobs Cooperative site lists nonprofit employment opportunities from coast-to-coast by working with local partners in each region. The goal is to help nonprofits find and hire qualified staff dedicated to the nonprofit sector.

The Cooperative is unique among nonprofit jobs sites in that all decisions about pricing and policies are determined at the local level by the local nonprofit partners. Peter Manzo, Executive Director of the Center for Nonprofit Management, said, "Local nonprofit support organizations understand the needs of their regions best. Rather than forcing every region into the same mold, each local partner decides how to best serve their local nonprofits. And because we believe the revenue from ads should help fund local programs and services, 100% of ad revenue goes directly to the local partner, not to any corporation or organization outside the region."

The site will also benefit job seekers eager to find opportunities in the nonprofit sector. Individuals will be able to search by geographic region, job title, category or organization name to find their ideal position. Bethany Kendall, President and CEO of Executive Service Corps of New England, said, "This new partnership will deliver tremendous value to nonprofits and job seekers by delivering a regional site that also has national scope. Customers get the best of both worlds."

The Center for Nonprofit Management has published nonprofit jobs listings since 1994, through a print newsletter, *Nonprofit Directions*, and through the Web since 2002. The Center will continue to publish its weekly print edition. The Center for Nonprofit Management fosters healthy neighborhoods and communities by improving the performance of nonprofit organizations addressing critical issues and serving underserved populations. Established in 1979 by the corporate and foundation community, the Center for Nonprofit Management helps nonprofit organizations more effectively fulfill their missions.
